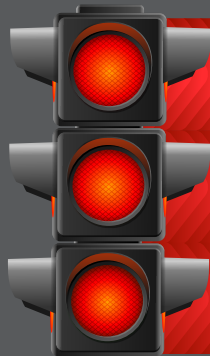

10 Possible Signs of an Impaired Driver

1. Driving unreasonably fast, slow or at an inconsistent speed
2. Drifting in and out of lanes
3. Tailgating and changing lanes frequently
4. Making exceptionally wide turns
5. Changing lanes or passing without sufficient clearance
6. Overshooting or stopping well before stop signs or stop lights
7. Disregarding signals and lights
8. Approaching signals or leaving intersections too quickly or slowly
9. Driving without headlights, failing to lower high beams or leaving turn signals on
10. Driving with windows open in cold or inclement weather

Information to provide when calling 911

- Your location
- Vehicle description: licence plate number, and colour, make and model of the vehicle
- Vehicle's direction of travel
- Description of the driver

Safety reminders

- Please observe all safety rules
- Keep your distance from the impaired driver
- Be cautious when using a cell phone to call 911; if you are driving, pull over
- Never try to apprehend the impaired driver yourself
